Figures: Original figures should be in high quality with the resolution of 600dpi and saved filename.jpg. Figures should be in the proper size, less than 8 cm or 16 cm in width, and less than 24 cm in height. Use a normal, uniform font (Times New Roman, 9 points, no bold, no italics) for all the words and numbers in figures. Only the first letter of the first word in line one should be capitalized, except proper nouns.

Tables: Use a normal, uniform font (Times New Roman, 9 points, no bold, no italics) for all the words and numbers in tables. Only the first letter of the first word in line one should be capitalized, except proper nouns.
